- **I. CALL TO ORDER:** Meeting was called to order by John Ketchum at 1:10pm.
- A. Roll Call
- B. Public Comment: None
- C. Communications: Keith received notification from the FCC that the license associated with the SCOFMP agreement needed some follow up. He will check to see what needs to be done.
- **II. OLD BUSINESS:** Brandon motioned to approve April meeting minutes, Mike seconded, motion carried unanimously.

Claims & Demands: Keith reviewed the following bills.

Garrett recommended taking an hour or so before a board meeting for the Day Wireless group to obtain additional knowledge from those board members who have the history; providing clear direction for what they would like to see in the future. Discussion followed regarding what that meeting would cover and what they would like to achieve.

Garrett confirmed everything Keith had said and added that he had a quote to provide as well. They will be onsite on the 13th and could do this meeting at that time.

Keith said whichever members are available could meet and update the others at their regular meeting. John asked if the microwave quote was based on a previous ask or something different. Garret said the quote provides an accurate number based on information from the MCP study to give a good idea of the project cost.

Work Session will take place on June 13th at 11am. Garrett, Jeff Springer-Service Manager of Oregon, and Chris Kay-Sales Manager of Oregon will attend this meeting in person.

III. NEW BUSINESS: Brandon informed the State has licensed VMED 29 air; med to ground use. He wanted to inform everyone so they can add it to their channel and be aware of this. The frequency is 155.3475.
